Qualification: BTEC Level 1/2
Equivalent to: 1 GCSE (grade 1-4)



This is the ideal course for students who enjoy learning through practical experience. The WorkSkills Course provides the A, B, C of employability – Attitude, Behaviour and Communication. The course is delivered over 2 years, during this time students will have the opportunity to benefit from a combination of work experience, input from guest speakers, enterprise activities and from staff with business expertise.

Course Content

During Key Stage 4 students will study a number of units that are directly linked to the workplace, some of which include;-

- Searching for a Job
- Developing a CV
- Applying for a Job
- Planning an Enterprise Activity
- Running an Enterprise Activity
- Making a Product
- Preparing for Work Placement
- Learning from Work Placement
- Preparing for an Interview
- Working in a Team

Assessment

The course is assessed internally through practical tasks, work experience, activities and logbooks that record student progress. There are no exams.
