



Uniform

The purpose of our uniform is to contribute to the business-like atmosphere of the school and create a sense of school identity. Staff will check at the start of each lesson/session that students are presenting themselves appropriately for school and in accordance with the uniform list.

Students are expected to wear school uniform throughout the school day, en route to and from school and on school trips unless advised otherwise by staff. Please provide a note to explain any temporary reason for a student's being out of uniform. Students out of uniform will be treated in accordance with BfL measures and will be provided with shoes, skirts and/or pullovers by Student Services for the day.

Girls

Boys

Archway School blue v-necked pullovers, skirts with logos and the school ties are available from Batemans Sports in Stroud (www.batemanssports.co.uk). All other items are available from Trutex Schoolwear in Stroud.

Tights must be black or grey. They must be thick and non-patterned. Thinner plain/tan tights and grey, white or black ankle socks can be worn in the summer.

Plain black **shoes** either flat or with low heels. Shoes must be plain, entirely black and should not be canvas. Boots cannot be worn in school although they may be worn on the journey to and from school.

Coats cannot be worn in lessons, registration or assembly. Hoodies/optional fleece may only be worn when participating in a school sports event. They cannot be worn at any other time.

Hairstyles should not be extreme in either style or colour. Shoulder length hair should be tied back in lessons where it may be hazardous. Only "natural" hair colours are acceptable.

The only **jewellery** which may be worn in school is one plain stud worn in the normal position in pierced ears. Students will be asked to remove any jewellery other than those agreed in the uniform code regardless of when the piercing was done. Covered piercings will not be acceptable.

Make up and nail varnish are not allowed in Years 7, 8 and 9. A discreet amount of makeup is acceptable in Years 10 and 11. Nail varnish is not allowed. Year 10 & 11 students may wear a small amount of foundation, blusher, mascara and a thin line of eyeliner. No extreme application of makeup. No colours. No lipstick or eyeshadow. Students are expected to respond to the notion of “discreet” with maturity. Students will be expected to remove makeup deemed by staff to be excessive.

Tee Shirts can be worn under shirts but must not be visible.

If a student is not wearing the correct uniform they will be asked to go to Student Services to put on a pullover, skirt, tie or shoes for the remainder of the day, or to remove make up or jewellery.

Please note – no three quarter length trousers are allowed for girls or boys.

Leggings are not permitted in Years 7 and 8.

Girls in Years 9-11 may wear navy blue leggings with Archway logo available from Batemans Sports. (Please note that these may be worn for PE lessons only, not to fixtures.)

All articles of clothing, kit etc, should be CLEARLY MARKED with the student's name, using name tape or marking ink.

PE kit may be embroidered with the student's name (service available at Batemans Sports).
