

ADMISSIONS POLICY

The Local Authority's Admission Policy for Archway School is as follows:

Students will be admitted at age 11, without reference to ability, aptitude or race gender.

Where applications for admission exceed the number of places available, the following criteria will be applied, in the order set out below, to decide which children to admit:-

- a) Children living in the priority catchment area normally served by the school
- b) Children wishing to join an older brother or sister already attending the school
- c) Having any authenticated medical reason for attending the school
- d) The proximity of the child's home to the school, with those living nearer being accorded the highest priority. The distance will be measured by the shortest walking route.

Students transferring for whom Archway is closer to home than their designated secondary school will be entitled, if the distance is over 3 miles, to free travel.
