RE: Update on Online Learning

Year 10

As year 10 are in school on one day a week we are making changes to their home learning.

From next week, work will be set in their English, Maths and Science lessons; if your child is not attending next week this information will be posted on Show My Homework.

All other subjects will be setting the same quantity of work but this will now be set only once a week and will have a one-week deadline. This will help students manage their time with their learning now being split between online and in school.
