Dear Year 11 Students

I know that your time in Year 11 was cut short and we were not able to do many of the usual celebratory events that would take place. - Students in tutor groups -
 - 11B & 11C should collect results between 8.30-9.00am
 - 11E & 11P should collect results between 9.15-9.45am
 - 11R & 11S should collect results between 10.00-10.30am
 - 11U & 11W should collect results between 10.30-11.00am
- Results will be available from the sports hall.
- There will be a socially distanced outside queue as we will restrict the amount of people inside at any one time.
- Please use the hand sanitiser on the wall outside the sports hall reception.
- Enter the main sports hall and collect your results.
- Once you have collected your results please exit using the fire doors on to the school field.
- Please wait until you are outside to open your results.
- There will be staff available for information, advice and guidance for all students that need this.
- Please always remember social distancing.
- Parents/carers should not gather at entrance to the school.
- Please return any textbooks or library books you have at home – you will be able to leave these in a designated area.

If you would like someone to collect your results on your behalf, please email Mrs Ryall using the email address below, you will need to do this by 14th August 2020. You must state the name of the person collecting the results and confirm that you give your permission for them to do this. The named person will need to bring photographic ID (driving license/passport etc)
